## More blessed is to give than to receive

Acts 20:35 "In everything I showed you that thus you ought to support the weak with our hands by laboring. And the words of the Adon (Master) Yahushua, that He Himself said, "It is blessed (good) to give than to receive."; 2 Cor. 9:5-7 ...and arrange your promised blessing in the front of you to be prepared as of a blessing and not as of a gift of covetousness. But behold, the one who sows sparingly shall also reap sparingly, and he who sows for the blessing shall also reap on the blessing, Each one as he has purposed in his heart, not in the evil eye nor of necessity, for Elohim loves him, a cheerful giver, in his heart.; Ps. 21:26; 37:21; Luke 6:38 "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap." Prov. 3:9; 11:24-5; 1 Tim. 6:17-19; Matt. 6:1-4; 1 Cor. 13:3; 2 Cor. 9:7, 11; Deut. 15:10; 2 Chr. 31:5; Lev. 27:30; 1 Chr. 29:9

What is given (what is sown) is blessed to multiply and what is received (what is reaped / harvested). Matt 13:23 "But he that received seed into the good ground is he that hears the word, and understand it; which also bears fruit and brings forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty." What is labored is to cultivate the ground (to sanctify the repented heart by His blood at His Aleph coming) in preparing the sowing of the seed of faith as to fulfill the spiritual life at the end of the harvest (end of fleshly life at His Tau coming).

Tithing and offerings (donations) are blessed to give (sow) in the ministry of the Gospel reaching many to turn to His Kingdom of Light. The farmers do sow and receive then do give tithes and donations for more blessings and save what is remained for the yearly spending needs for foods to eat, the clothing to wear, the housing and farm and other needs to buy with the thankful prayers and the next sowing season to multiply more. What is given at the beginning/sowing time and it shall be given to you at the end/reaping time according to the saying of Luke 6:38.

The eternal cycle of the blessing to give in preparing to multiply what is sown in all generations to live. Without the giving/sowing, the receiving is nothing/empty because there is no multiplication and no blessings that lead to death/emptiness. (Galatians 5:17-21). The spiritual cycle of His blessings is eternal with the giving of our spiritual fruits to others (Galatians 5:22-23).

Those who have not repented from their carnal hearts are not sanctified with His blood in preparation of receiving the Holy Spirit, because they do not understand the spiritual concept of what is given more blessed than what is received nor the cycle of what is sowed with the seed of faith only on the sanctified (repentant) heart to fulfill the spiritual life at the harvest time. They, who are more interested in the earthly wealth, are without His blessings which lead to the emptiness at the end of their fleshly lives because they only see what is carnal in their visible things. 1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. That is why they need to repent from the kingdom of darkness in order to understand what is necessary to have their repentant (sanctified) hearts ready for the sowing time of the seed of the faith with the gift of Holy Spirit given to them. It can lead them to prosper their spiritual growth to fulfill the spiritual life.

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
